PAYMENT STRUCTURE/SCHEDULE.

The fees are payable in full at the beginning of each academic year semester or four installments at the beginning of each academic semester and mid semester.

All payments should be made on time at every start of these semesters for those who are paying in two semesters and every end of two months for those who are paying in four installments.

Note: no student will be allowed to seat for either internal or external examination even accessing the college services before completing his /her due payments.

PHARMACY PRACTISE /FIELD WORK

- ❖ For The Pharmaceutical Sciences Students Shall Be Required To Undergo a Six Weeks Compulsory Pharmacy Practice Placement/Field Work At a Community Pharmacy, Or Designated District Hospital Or Regional Referral Hospitals Assigned and Approved By the College at the End Of Semester One Of Each Academic Year For That Purpose
- ❖ During The Placement The Students Will Be Under Daily Instructions And Supportive Supervision Of Senior Qualified Pharmaceutical Personnel Of The Respective Hospital/Pharmacy Being Placed. Inspection And Supportive Supervision Visit Will Be Made By The Appointed Tutor
- ❖ Student Will Not Be Allowed To Continue With the Next Semester If She/he Fails To Undergo the Pharmacy Practice Field Work to Obtain the Required Credits.

- ❖ Pharmacy Students Will Be Required To search for their his/her own field placement area that meet standard set by college according to their level
- ❖ Pharmacy Students Will Be Required To Incur His/her Own Living Expenses (i.e. Accommodation, Meals, transport Cost, e.t.c)
- ❖ The College Will Cater cost at the field placement area (per head)
- ❖ The College Will Cater Attachment And Supervision Cost during field placement

CLINICAL ROTATIONS AND ENVIRONMENTAL FIELD WORK

- ❖ For The Clinical Medicine Students Shall Be Required To Undergo Four Weeks Compulsory Clinical Rotation In Semester Two At Designated District Hospital Or Health Center Or Regional Hospitals Assigned And Approved By The College.
- ❖ During Hospital Placement for the Clinical Practices Students Shall Be Under Daily Instructions and Supportive Supervision of Appointed Clinical Instructors from the Hospital. Inspection And Supportive Supervision Visit Will Be Made By The Appointed Tutor From The College.
- ❖ At The End Of First Semester One All Clinical Medicines Students Shall Be Required To Attend Two Weeks Environmental Field Work At The Designated Dispensaries And Wards Within The Municipal Councils.
- ❖ Transport To And Fro From The Hospital, Hospital Attachment Cost And Supervision Cost Shall Be Catered By The College From The Clinical Rotation Fee Paid By Each Student.
